### 2010 McDonald's Academic Excellence Award

**The McDonald's Academic Excellence Award is a one time \$2,500 Scholarship given to six high school seniors. Four whom are/have been/willing to be involved in either the Mathews-Dickey or the Herbert Hoover Boys and Girls Clubs and two attending East St. Louis High School (for a total of six scholarships).**

This criteria worksheet will enable the committee to determine the scholarship recipients. The following are explanations of the criteria:

- Counselor's Reference – Please check the score box if there are letters of reference corresponding the application.
- Essay - Each applicant is required to complete a one-page essay indicating their major area of study and their reasons for attending their selected college/university. Please rate the essay from 1 – 10 (with 10 being the best.)
- Course Content Transcript – Each applicant has included an official copy of their transcript and includes their course work and grades. Please indicate on the criteria sheet from 0-5 (with 5 being the most challenging level of course work.)
- Extra Curricular Activities – Each applicant indicates in their application their extra curricular activities. Please rate their community, school and other involvement in activities from 1-5 (with 5 being the most.)
- ACT/SAT Test Score – Each applicant has taken the ACT. Please rate the weight of the applicant's score on the criteria sheet. If they have received a score less than 18 – indicate a zero for that section.
- Family Financial Status-Each applicant is required to turn in proof of household income in order to be considered for the scholarship award. Acceptable forms of proof include 2008 W2 or paycheck stubs no older than one month.
- GPA – The applicants have included their high school GPA. Please indicate/rate the weight with their GPA. If an applicant has a GPA lower than 3.0 .
- Interview – Each applicant will participate in the interview process. Please rate the applicant from 1 to 10 (with 10 being the best) on how effectively they answer each question, their confidence level, and their potential and desire to attend college and achieve goals.

***\*Students wishing to apply for the scholarship can sign up for community service during the summer prior to high school graduation in order to qualify for the scholarship.***

**The McDonald's Academic Excellence Award is a one time \$2,500 scholarship given to six high school seniors. Four whom are/have been/ or are willing to complete 20 hours of community service with either Mathews-Dickey or Herbert Hoover Boys and Girls Clubs and two attending East St. Louis High School.**

1. African-American students in their senior year attending a St. Louis/Metro East area high school with at least a GPA of 3.0 (***\*\*special consideration for students with lower GPA's\*\****).
2. Students must possess leadership qualities, potential for success in college and involvement in school and community service.
3. Students must submit **typewritten** applications. Students must also include an official transcript; proof of honors received; school and community involvement activities; **proof of family income**; and proof of Mathews-Dickey or Herbert Hoover Boys & Girls Club association (see page 6). Applicants must prepare a one-two page typewritten, double-spaced essay stating the importance of Black History Month as it relates to the education.
4. Recommendations must be received from two (2) teachers or one (1) teacher and (1) counselor/principal/community service youth leader who are familiar with the student's academic performance and involvement in school and community service.
5. A letter of acceptance from the selected institution must be included with this application.
6. Your Federal Pell Grant status must be included with this application. This information can be found on your Student Aid Report (SAR). For additional information, contact your high school counselor or the financial aid office at your selected institution.
7. Based on the information provided on the application and the recommendations received, qualified students will be selected to participate in an interview, which will be conducted during the last week of March 2010.
8. The McDonald's and Herbert Hoover Boys & Girls Scholarship Committee will make the final scholarship selections by mid-April.
